It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that neither party to this suit shall again marry except to each other until sixty days after the rendition of this decree, and that if appeal is taken within sixty days, neither party shall again marry except to each other during the pendency of said appeal.

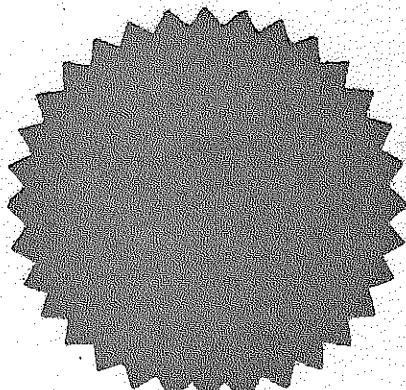
It is further ordered that Frank Tarvin and Pinkie Tarvin be, and they are hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon the payment of the cost of this suit.

Comes your Complainant, Frank Tarvin, and exhibits this,
his Bill of Complaint in this cause for divorce against Pinkie

That your Complainant is a bona fide resident of Baldwin

two years next preceding the filing of this Bill of Complaint,
and that your Complainant and the Respondent have not lived to-
gether as man and wife during said period of time.

PRAYER FOR PROCESS AND RELIEF.

THE PREMISES CONSIDERED, your Complainant prays that all
necessary notices, orders and decrees be issued to make the above
named Pinkie Tarvin party defendant, requiring her to appear and
plead, answer or demur within the time and under the penalties
prescribed by the rules of this Court and the statutes in such cases
made and provided; that upon a final hearing hereof your Honor will
order, adjudge and decree that the bonds of matrimony heretofore

existing between the Complainant and your Respondent be forever dissolved, and that your complainant be again permitted to contract the marriage relation should he so desire. Should your complainant be mistaken in the relief prayed for that there be granted to him such other, further and different relief to which he is in equity and good conscience entitled, and as in duty bound he will ever pray.

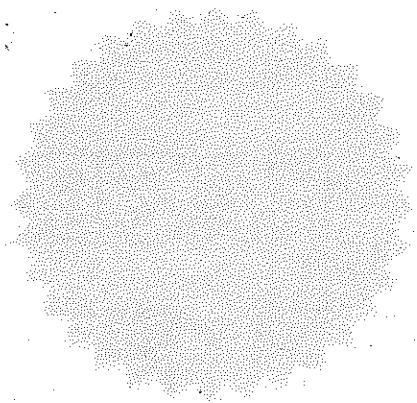
