1. The Plaintiff claims of the Defendant the sum of One Hundred Fifty-Three and No/100 Dollars (\$153.00) due on a promissory note made by the Defendant on, to-wit, August 12, 1948, and payable to the Plaintiff on the 12th day of October, 1948, which note is the property of the Plaintiff and, together with the interest thereon at the rate of eight (8) per cent per annum, is still due and unpaid.

2. The Plaintiff claims of the Defendant the further and additional sum of Seven and No/100 Dollars (\$7.00), the balance due on a promissory note originally for Forty-seven and No/100 Dollars (\$47.00) made by the Defendant on to-wit, September 4, 1948, and payable to the Plaintiff on the 11th day of September, 1948, which note is the property of the Plaintiff and, together with the interest thereon at

the rate of eight (8) per cent per annum, is still due and unpaid.

The Plaintiff avers that the Defendant made a payment of Twenty-five and No/100 Dollars (\$25.00) on the said note on November 1, 1949, and a payment of Fifteen and No/100 Dollars (\$15.00) on the said note on December 7, 1949. Plaintiff avers that it is entitled to the sum of Three and 50/100 Dollars (\$3.50), as interest on the said Twenty-five Dollars and the said Fifteen Dollars from September 11, 1948, to the date of the said payments, which sum the Plaintiff herewith claims.

3. The Plaintiff further avers that in and by the terms and provisions of the said notes the Defendant waived all rights of exemptions as to these debts, and agreed to pay a reasonable attorney's fee for the collection of the same, which attorney's fee the Plaintiff alleges to be Thirty-five Dollars (\$35.00) and which it herewith claims.

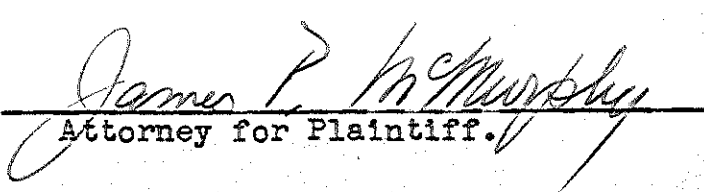
