

TO ANY SHERIFF OF THE STATE OF ALABAMA - GREETING:

Whereas James R. Owen has made affidavit as required by law that T. J. Davidson, doing business as People's Market, at the June 16, 1950, Term of the Circuit Court of Baldwin County recovered a judgment against Harvey Trawick for the sum of Two Hundred Two and 96/100 Dollars (\$202.96), and the further sum of Ten and 45/100 Dollars (\$10.45), cost of suit; and that he believes the process of garnishment is necessary to obtain satisfaction of said judgment, and that Baldwin County Bank has, or is believed to have in its possession or under its control, money or effects belonging to the defendant, or that it is or is believed to be indebted to the defendant, or to be liable to him on a contract for the delivery of personal property, or on a contract for the payment of money which may be discharged by the delivery of personal property, or which is payable in personal property.

Having fully answered the said garnishment, Garnishee prays that it be discharged with its reasonable costs in this behalf expended.

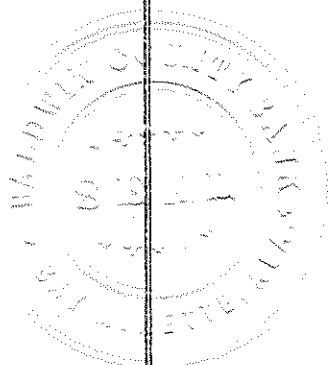
