California, and shows unto this Court and unto your Honor as
follows:

FIRST:

That your Petitioner is the father of Diane Corwin,
who is a girl, fifteen years of age. That the said Diane Corwin
is now living with Louella Boothe, her mother, in Fairhope, Baldwin
County, Alabama. That the said Diane Corwin is now illegally
restrained of her liberty in Baldwin County, Alabama, by the said
Louella Boothe.

WHEREFORE, your Petitioner prays that a Writ of
Habeas Corpus be issued by this Court directed to Louella Boothe,
commanding her to bring the body of Diane Corwin before your Honor
at a time and place to be by you appointed, together with the
cause of her detention.

FINAL DECREE

This matter coming on to be heard on the petition of William T. Corwin, as the father of Diane Corwin, and on behalf of said Diane Corwin for a Writ of Habeas Corpus and upon the said Diane Corwin being brought into open court by her mother, Louella Boothe, and after consultation with said minor by the court, it appeared to the court that the said Diane Corwin desired to be placed in the custody of her father, William T. Corwin, who is a resident of Newhall, California, and that it was to the best interest of said minor.

It is therefore ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the court that the petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus be, and the same is hereby granted and that Diane Corwin is hereby placed in the care and under the custody and control of her father, William T. Corwin.

It is further ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the court that the said Diane Corwin, upon proper provisions for her transportation being made by her father, William T. Corwin, shall leave the home of her mother, Mrs. Louella Boothe in Baldwin County, Alabama, at such time so that she shall arrive in Newhall, California, not later than August 28, 1950.

It is further ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the court that at the end of the school year in California in 1951, that if such minor child should so desire, she shall be permitted by her father to return to Baldwin County, Alabama, and live with her mother for such length of time as she shall desire and that her father shall provide her necessary transportation costs.
