



This cause coming on to be heard and it appearing to the Court that on April 19, 1951, at the Spring Term of the Circuit Court of Baldwin County, Alabama, J. E. Paterson Lumber Company, the Plaintiff herein, recovered a judgment against E. C. Steedley in the sum of \$120.80 and for the further sum of \$21.95, the costs of said suit; and it further appearing to the court that Norborne C. Stone, one of the attorneys of record for the plaintiff in said aforementioned cause, did file an affidavit in this court stating that he believed the process of garnishment was necessary to obtain satisfaction of such judgment and that thereupon Alice J. Duck did issue a writ of garnishment directing the Sheriff to summon George Lambert to be and appear before this Honorable Court to make answer whether or not he was indebted to the defendant, E. C. Steedley, at the time of the issuance of said writ and it further appearing to the court that the said George Lambert, Garnishee, did, on the 18th day of January, 1952, file in this court his answer in writing, under oath, denying that he was indebted to the said defendant by contract then existing or that he had in his possession or under his control, property or things in action belonging to said defendant; and it further appearing to the court that the Plaintiff herein, acting by and through its attorneys, did make a demand for oral examination of the Garnishee and that this court did thereafter enter an order requiring the Garnishee to answer orally in open court the writ of garnishment served upon him and that a citation was duly issued to him by the Clerk of this Court and served upon him by the Sheriff of Baldwin County, Alabama, and the said George Lambert having appeared in open Court on February 11, 1952, and made his oral answer to the writ of garnishment in accordance with the order heretofore rendered

by this court; the court having considered said testimony and the oral answer of the said Garnishee and the testimony of the said Garnishee on the hearing aforesaid, as recorded by the Court Reporter, is of the opinion that the said George Lambert was indebted to the Defendant, E. C. Steedley and that the written answer heretofore filed by him is overcome by the testimony and disclosures made on the said oral examination; it is, therefore,

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court that the Plaintiff, J. E. Paterson Lumber Company have and recover of George Lambert, Garnishee, the sum of \$142.75, together with the costs in this behalf expended.

It is further ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court that if the debt owing by the Garnishee to the Defendant is not in an amount equal to the amount mentioned above that the said George Lambert pay to the Clerk of this Court the total amount of his indebtedness to the said E. C. Steedley from the date the original writ of garnishment was served until the date hereof and that subsequent hereto he pay to the said Clerk of this Court any further indebtedness owing by him to E. C. Steedley until such time as said total amount of the judgment and costs and the costs of this proceeding have been paid in full.

It is further ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that upon the payment by the said Garnishee of the total amount due hereunder that he be discharged and released from the writ of garnishment heretofore served upon him in this Court.

It is further ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that execution may issued for all the amounts ordered to be paid hereby.

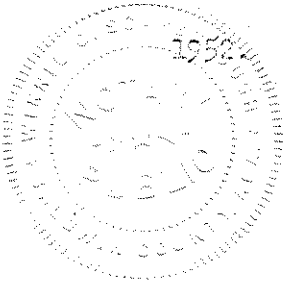

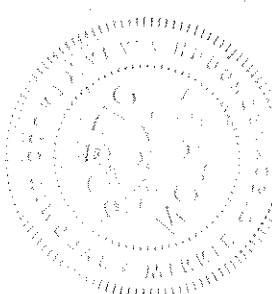

for 10 weeks 23 October 1949 to 27 April 1950, a total of 26 weeks 4 days has been  
paid, being in the sum of \$388.47

; all subject to the limitations of said Act, and the employee agrees to give proper receipts for each payment made hereunder.

The employee acknowledges that he has received to date medical and surgical treatment and benefits given by said Act ~~and the employer agrees to continue to furnish the same, if any be necessary, to the extent and in the manner required by said Act. The employee agrees to present himself for examination, or if physically unable to do so, to submit to examination by the physician or physicians designated by the employer when requested.~~

This settlement is substantially in accordance with Sections 7550 and 7551 of the 1923 Code of Ala., as amended. When all payments hereunder have been made the employer shall be, and hereby is released from all claims on account of said injury, under said Act or otherwise. This settlement contains the whole agreement between the parties hereto.
