

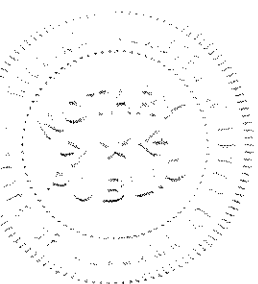

COUNT 1

The plaintiff claims of the defendant the sum of One Hundred Eighty-five and 19/100 (\$185.19) Dollars, together with the interest thereon from, to-wit, the 31st day of March, 1951, which sum of money, with the interest thereon, is still unpaid.

COUNT 2

The plaintiff claims of the defendant the sum of One Hundred Eighty-five and 19/100 (\$185.19) Dollars, together with the interest thereon from, to-wit, the 31st day of March, 1951, due from him from account stated between the plaintiff and the defendant on, to-wit, the 31st day of March, 1951, which sum of money, with the interest thereon, is still unpaid.

COUNT 3

The plaintiff claims of the defendant the sum of One Hundred Eighty-five and 19/100 (\$185.19) Dollars, due from him for work and labor done for the defendant by the plaintiff on, to-wit, the 31st day of March, 1951, at his request, which sum of money, with the interest thereon, is still unpaid.
