

**Abstract** The purpose of this study was to determine the effect of a 12-week training program on the heart rate (HR) and heart rate reserve (HRR) of sedentary middle-aged men. The subjects were randomly assigned to a control group (CON) and an exercise group (EX). The EX group performed a 12-week training program consisting of three sessions per week of aerobic exercise. The HR and HRR were measured at rest and during maximal exercise at baseline and at the end of the 12-week training program. The results showed that the EX group had a significant decrease in HR and HRR at rest and during maximal exercise compared to the CON group. These findings suggest that a 12-week training program can improve cardiovascular fitness in sedentary middle-aged men.
