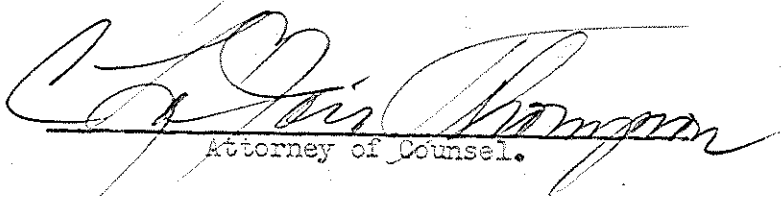
COUNT ONE
