The Plaintiff claims of the Defendant, THREE THOUSAND (\$3000.00) DOLLARS as damages for that on, to-wit, November 30, 1951, at the intersection of Morphy Avenue and Greeno Boulevard within the limits of Fairhope, Baldwin County, Alabama, the Defendant, acting by and through his servant, agent or employee who was then and there acting within the line and scope of his employment negligently drove an automobile truck into or against an automobile belonging to the Plaintiff, and as the proximate result of the negligence on the part of the servant, agent or employee of the Defendant, George Bolar, while acting within the line and scope of his employment the automobile of the Plaintiff was demolished.


The Plaintiff claims of the Defendant THREE THOUSAND (\$3000.00) DOLLARS as damages for that on, to-wit, November 30, 1951, at approximately 10:45 P.M., James Joseph Trione was driving an automobile belonging to the Plaintiff on or along Morphy Avenue in Fairhope, Alabama, in a westerly direction; that the Defendant acting by and through his agent, servant or employee Ernest Anderson who was then and there acting within the line and scope of his employment was operating an automobile truck Southwardly along Greeno Boulevard in Fairhope, Baldwin County, Alabama; that at the intersection of Morphy Avenue and the said Greeno Boulevard, the said Ernest Anderson,

the agent, servant or employee of the Defendant, while acting within the line and scope of his employment negligently drove said automobile truck, which he was then and there driving into or against the said automobile of the Plaintiff and as a proximate result of said negligence the automobile of the Plaintiff was demolished.
