The plaintiff claims of the defendant, A. E. Lundberg, \$116.50, damages for the breach of a written agreement entered into between the plaintiff and the defendant on October 31, 1951, in substance as follows:

The plaintiff agreed to sell and the defendant agreed to purchase roofing materials, to wit, 46 gallons of Zone Heavy-Duty Roof Coating, 35 gallons of Zone Heavy-Duty Roof Primer, and 2 rolls Glass Membrane, in the amount of \$116.50. It was expressly agreed that the roofing materials were not sold on consignment and that the title to the roofing materials passed to the purchaser upon delivery to the transportation company.

And the plaintiff says that although it has complied with all the provisions of the agreement on its part and has demanded payment for the aforementioned roofing materials, the defendant has failed to comply with the terms of the agreement in that he has failed to pay for the aforementioned roofing materials.

II

The plaintiff claims of the defendant, A. E. Lundberg, \$116.50, due from him for merchandise, goods, and chattels sold by the plaintiff to the defendant on the 7th day of November, 1951, which sum of money with interest thereon is still unpaid.

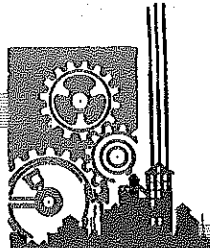
