AFFIDAVIT OF R. WALLACE MURPHY

R. WALLACE MURPHY, first being duly sworn, deposes and says as follows:

My name is R. WALLACE MURPHY. On October 4, 1946, EDWARD E. ORENSTEIN and DOROTHY ORENSTEIN, executed the note in my favor in the principal amount of ONE THOUSAND & 00/100 DOLLARS (\$1,000), due and payable October 4, 1947.

No payments have been made either on the principal or on the interest. Said note also provides for the legal rate of interest together with five per centum (5%) of the amount of the debt and interest as counsel fee.

Said note also provides that the makers jointly and severally waive the benefit of any and all exemptions under the laws of the State of Delaware or elsewhere.

The said EDWARD E. ORENSTEIN and DOROTHY ORENSTEIN, owe the principal amount of ONE THOUSAND & 00/100 DOLLARS (\$1,000), plus interest at the legal rate from October 4, 1946, to date, plus other fees, and this amount is a just debt after allowing all due credit.
