COUNT I:

The Plaintiff claims of the Defendant the sum of ONE HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN & 00/100 DOLLARS (\$167.00), due by promissory note made by him on the 12th day of November, 1952 and due and payable on or before 90 days from date, with interest thereon.

Said note also provided for a reasonable attorney's fee which the Plaintiff alleges to be Thirty Dollars (\$50.00).

COUNT II:

The Plaintiff claims of the Defendant the sum of ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00) for the reason that, on the 16th day of October, 1951, a judgement was rendered against the Defendant in favor of the Plaintiff which judgement is recorded in Book 005, page 168. On the 12th day of November, 1952, said Defendant went to the office of Forest A. Christian, Attorney at Law, Foley, Alabama and represented that he had already paid the sum of ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00) to the sheriff of Baldwin County, showing said attorney a receipt from sheriff for ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100) and represented that this ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100) was to be applied on the judgement referred to above. The said Forest A. Christian thereupon gave him credit in the amount of ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100) in anticipation of recieving this sum of money from sheriff of Baldwin County, Alabama, and thereupon released said judgement. However, the sheriff later advised the said attorney that said receipt was in payment of a judgement in favor of one AMOS GARRETT. This sum of money with interest thereon is still unpaid.
