
PRAYER FOR PROCESS.


PRAYER FOR RELIEF.

DECREE OF DIVORCE.

This cause coming on to be heard was submitted on the Complainant's Bill, Respondent's Answer and the Testimony as noted by the Register, and upon consideration thereof, the Court is of the opinion that the Complainant is entitled to the relief prayed for in her said Bill.

It is, therefore, Ordered, Adjudged and Decreed by the Court, that the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the Complainant and Respondent be, and the same are hereby dissolved and the said Clara Enzor is forever divorced from the said Audabun Enzor for and on account of the facts alleged in her said Bill of Complaint.

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that the said Clara Enzor be, and she is hereby granted the custody of the minor child, Audabun Enzor, Jr.

It is further Ordered that the said Clara Enzor be and she is hereby permitted to again contract marriage but shall not again marry except to the said Audabun Enzor until sixty days after this date, and if an appeal is taken within sixty days, she shall not marry again except to the said Audabun Enzor during the pendency of said appeal.
