BILL OF COMPLAINT


Plaintiff claims of the Defendant ONE HUNDRED FORTY-ONE and 21/100 DOLLARS (\$141.20), due by promissory note, made by Defendant on March 23, 1968 and payable March 23, 1969.

Plaintiff further avers that in and by the terms of said note, the Defendant agreed to pay interest at the rate of Eight (8%) Percent per annum from March 23, 1968, and Plaintiff claims of the Defendant such interest in the amount of SEVENTY NINE and 03/100 DOLLARS (\$79.03).

Plaintiff further avers that in and by the terms of said note, the Defendant waives notice of presentment and all right of exemption under the Constitution and Laws of Alabama, or any other State, as to personal property, as to which waiver the Plaintiff now claims the benefit.

Plaintiff further avers that in and by the terms of said note, the Defendant agreed to pay all costs of collection or securing

or attempting to collect or secure said note, including a reasonable attorney's fee, and the Plaintiff further claims of the Defendant the further and additional sum of FORTY FOUR DOLLARS (\$44.00) as such reasonable attorney's fee.
