COUNT ONE:

The Plaintiff claims of the Defendant the sum of Five Hundred and No/100 Dollars (\$500.00) as damages for that on heretofore, to-wit, November 4, 1952, Fred Faulkner, so negligently operated a motor vehicle on U. S.
