ANSWER OF GARNISHEE

Comes now F. T. LUTTRELL, Vice President of SCOTT-LUTTRELL, INC., a corporation, garnishee in the above styled cause, on this the 2nd day of October, 1953, who being duly sworn, deposes and says:

1. That he is the Vice President of Scott-Luttrell, Inc., a corporation, and as such is authorized to make this answer; that he has personal knowledge of the facts herein stated and is authorized to sign this answer to said garnishment; that at the time of the service of said writ of garnishment and at the time of the making this answer to said garnishment, Scott-Luttrell, Inc., a corporation, was and is indebted to said defendants as hereinafter set out; that by contract now in existence dated on, to-wit, the 14th day of April, 1953, defendants agreed to construct a building at Robertsdale, Alabama for garnishee according to plans and specifications for the sum of, to-wit, Eight Thousand, Two Hundred Seventy-Six And 96/100 (\$8,276.96) Dollars; that said building is not yet complete, there still being gutters and downspouts to install, and some other small items; that defendant constructed authorized extras on said job but in an amount not now known by garnishee, but said extras will not exceed the sum of, to-wit, Two Hundred (\$200) Dollars.

That prior to the service of the writ in this case, garnishee had paid to defendant or defendant's materialmen or suppliers the sum of, to-wit, Three Thousand Three Hundred Fifty-Two And 63/100 (\$3,352.63) Dollars; that prior to the service of the writ in this case, garnishee agreed with the suppliers and materialmen to pay them for the supplies and materials used on said job; that the amount of the materials and supplies so delivered on said job for the payment of which the garnishee agreed to pay, amounts to the sum of Two Thousand, Seven Hundred Fifty-Nine And 69/100 (\$2,759.69) Dollars; that prior to the time of the service of the writ in this case, garnishee agreed with the laborers on said job to pay each of them the actual cost of manhours to each laborer on said job; that the total amount of labor paid to each individual worker on said job amounts to the sum of, to-wit, Two Thousand Ninety-Three And 73/100 (\$2,093.73) Dollars; that the total amount paid or assumed to be paid under said job amounts to the sum of Eight Thousand, Two Hundred Six And 05/100 (\$8,206.05) Dollars leaving a balance of Seventy And 91/100 (\$70.91) Dollars which will be due when the defendants perform in full as agreed under said contract plus the amount of said extras; that garnishee will not be liable to the defendants for the delivery of personal property or for the payment of money which may be discharged by the delivery of personal property or which is payable in personal property and garnishee has not in its possession or under its control money or effects belonging to the defendants other than as aforesaid.
