TO THE HONORABLE F. W. HARE, JUDGE OF THE CIRCUIT COURT OF BALDWIN COUNTY, ALABAMA, SITTING IN EQUITY:

Your Orator, R. H. Oswell, brings this his Bill of Complaint against Eli Bassett and Julius Bassett, and thereupon your Orator complains and shows unto the Court as follows:

- l. Your Orator is over the age of twenty-one years and resides in Mobile County, Alabama; the Defendants are over the age of twenty-One years and reside in Baldwin County, Alabama.
- 2. Your Orator is the owner of the following described land in Baldwin County, Alabama, to-wit: That portion of Section 42, Township I South Range 2 East of St. Stephens Meridian, beginning at a point where the west line of the public road from Bay Minette intersects Hastie Lake, and running thence South 23 degrees East eight hundred (800) feet, thence south 141 degrees East 1450 feet, thence South 632 degrees West 2590 feet, more or less, to the East bank of said Hastie Lake, thence northeasterly along the East bank of said Hastie Lake to the place of beginning, containing 68 acres, more or less. ALSO the following described tract of land beginning at the intersection of the south line of Section 42 Township 1 South, Range 2 East and the east bank of Hastie Lake, running thence south 87 degrees East 240 feet, thence North 21 degrees East 1200 feet, thence North 882 degrees East 3680 feet more or less, to the West side of bay Minette Public Road, thence along the west line of said public road north 5 degrees West 504 feet, thence North 32 degrees West 965 feet, thence North 772 degrees West 2660 feet, more or less to the east bank of Hastie Lake, said point being 300 feet South of the point on Hastie Lake as described in the first tract. Your Orator further prays for such other, further and general relief as he may be equitably entitled to the premises considered.
