Phillips against a 1946 International Truck, Model KB-5, 1½ ton, Serial number m23369051, belonging to the said Sankey Reed for labor and materials on said truck furnished by the said Paul C. Phillips in the amount of Two Hundred Twenty-one and Seventy-eight hundredths dollars (\$221.78) and has obtained the same, returnable to the present term of the Circuit Court of Baldwin County, Alabama.



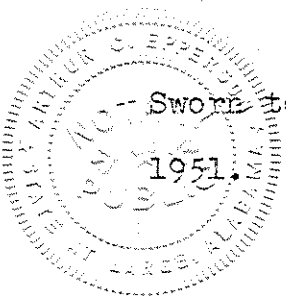
