Personally appeared before me the undersigned authority in and for said State and County, H. G. Zeigler, who is personally known to me, who being by me duly sworn, on oath says, that he is the City Comptroller and ex officio treasurer of the City of Mobile, a Municipal Corporation, and that he is the agent of the City of Mobile, a Municipal Corporation, for making answer in garnishment cases, and that he has authority to make answer for the garnishee in the above styled cause, and he has knowledge of the facts hereinafter stated in answer to the said garnishment, and answering the garnishment herein he says that the garnishee is presently paying to the Defendant the sum of ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY TWO AND 50/100 (\$172.50) DOLLARS per month, pursuant to the provisions of the Act of Legislature of Alabama of 1951, approved September 11, 1951, General Acts of Alabama of 1951, page 1343, (Title 62, Section 491 (1) to 491 (27), as amended by an Act of the 1953 Legislature, approved August 26, 1953, contained in the General Acts of Alabama of 1953, page 505,) and that the garnishee is not now indebted to the Defendant for any sums other than as stated, and that it will not be indebted in the future to the said Defendant by any contract then or now existing, otherwise than as heretofore stated, and that it will not be liable to the Defendant for the delivery of personal property by any contract then or now existing, for the delivery of personal property, nor for the payment of money which may be discharged by the delivery of personal property or which is payable in personal property, and that it

has not in its possession or under its control money or effects belonging to the Defendant, other than as hereinabove stated.

That, as is above stated, the garnishee is indebted to the said Defendant for the sum of ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY TWO AND 50/100 (\$172.50) DOLLARS per month, which money so due the Defendant is not subject to garnishment under the laws of the State of Alabama as contained in Section 10 of the Act of the 1951 Alabama Legislature approved on September 11, 1951, and contained in the Acts of Alabama of 1951, page 1344, and the garnishee prays that it may therefore be discharged with its reasonable cost.


