Humbly complaining, Your Oratrix, Lennie Young, respectfully represents
unto your Honor as follows:-


1. That your Oratrix, the said Lennie Young, and Whit Young, the said
Respondent, were legally married, on towit, May 12th, 1935, at Bay Minette,
Alabama in said Baldwin County and lived together as husband and wife,
until, towit, July 12th, 1937, when they separated and they have not since
lived together as husband and wife. Your Oratrix has ^{been} for more than three
years, prior to the filing of the Bill of Complaint, a bona fide resident
of Baldwin County, Alabama and the respondent was, also, up to the time
he abandoned your Oratrix on, towit, July 12th, 1937. Both your Oratrix
and the respondent are over the age of twenty one years. Your Oratrix
resides at Bay Minette, Alabama and respondent when last he heard of was
residing in Pensacola, Florida, but his present post office address
is unknown to your Oratrix .

2. That after the marriage between your Oratrix and the respondent,
the said Whit Young became an "addick" to whiskey and became cruel
and mean to Oratrix and at times, while drinking, he would beat up your
Oratrix and otherwise mistreat her; that on the very day he left and
abandoned your Oratrix he gave your Oratrix a beating . Respondent's
conduct became such that your Oratrix had a reasonable apprehension of
great personal harm and injury to her person such as would endanger her
life .

dissolved and that your Honor, will, also, order, adjudge and decree

that your Oratrix may be permitted to marry again and that she be granted such other and further relief as may in equity and good conscience seem meet and proper to your Honor.


