GUESS, MARY JO GUESS, and the undersigned, are held and firmly bound unto TAYLOR WILKINS, Sheriff of Baldwin County, Alabama, in the sum of \$1560.00, for the payment of which, well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, and each of us, our heirs, executors and administrators, jointly, severally and firmly by these presents, and as part of this undertaking we hereby waive all our rights under the Constitution and Laws of the State of Alabama, to have any of our property exempt from levy and sale in satisfaction hereof.

SEALED with our seals and dated this 8th day of November, 1969.

NOW, THEREFORE, the condition of the foregoing obligation is such, that on the 7th day of November, 1969, the Justice Court of R. A. Godwin, Fairhope, Alabama, ordered the principals, Lawrence B. Guess and Mary Jo Guess to give up the possession of certain property the subject of a proceedings in the said Court brought by DONALD W. BUSBY as plaintiff under authority of Alabama Code of 1940, Title 31 Sections 35 through 45, from which order and decision an appeal has been made to the Circuit Court of Baldwin County, Ala., and that if the said LAWRENCE B. GUESS and MARY JO GUESS shall prosecute their said appeal to effect, and satisfy such judgment as the Circuit Court may render in this case and pay the plaintiff all damages he may sustain by prosecution of this appeal, then this obligation to be NULL AND VOID, otherwise to remain in full force and effect.


