





Abstract

The purpose of this study was to determine whether there were differences in the prevalence of musculoskeletal disorders among different types of workers in the garment industry. The study included 600 employees from three garment factories in Mexico City. Data were collected by means of a self-administered questionnaire. Results showed that the prevalence of musculoskeletal disorders was higher among female than male workers. The prevalence of musculoskeletal disorders was also higher among workers who had been employed longer than those who had been employed shorter periods of time. The prevalence of musculoskeletal disorders was higher among workers who worked in the sewing department than those who worked in other departments. The prevalence of musculoskeletal disorders was higher among workers who worked in the cutting department than those who worked in other departments. The prevalence of musculoskeletal disorders was higher among workers who worked in the finishing department than those who worked in other departments.
