Dear Red:

There are two garnishments pending in the above matter. My records show that I wrote you two times back in November of 1972 about your client paying off according to his agreement.

Then the two cases were set for December 12, 1972 and I went to Court and got two Nisi Orders, one for Contempt and one for a final Judgment against the Garnishee. These Orders were sent to the Court that same afternoon, to be signed by the Judge.

On December 18, 1972 you call me and said that the Judge had called you about the case. You said you had the money to pay everything and wanted to know how much you needed to send me. I gave you an amount and said that it did not include the Costs since I did not know what they were. You said you would take care of them and also take care of having the two Garnishments dismissed.

The two cases were set again on the docket for March 12, 1973 and I wrote the clerk to the above effect, of which a copy is inclosed, on February 25, 1973. This letter has gone astray, I guess, because the case is not set for June 11, 1973. I wrote the clerk again on May 31, 1973, setting out most of this, and inclose a copy of that letter. She now tells me that I need to contact you and that is what I am doing. A copy of this goes to the Court and I do not know what else I can do.






