

TO THE HONORABLE F. W. HARE, JUDGE OF THE CIRCUIT COURT OF BALDWIN COUNTY, ALABAMA, SITTING IN EQUITY:

Your Petitioner, Claudia H. Dahlberg, respectfully represent unto the Court and your Honor as follows:

1. She is a resident citizen of Baldwin County, Alabama, over twenty-one years of age and is the mother of Willard McLeod Dahlberg, a minor over eighteen years of age, who resides with your Petitioner in Baldwin County, Alabama, but who is now in school at Auburn, Alabama, which said minor has no legal guardian.

2. Petitioner further shows unto the Court and your Honor that the said minor has an interest in real estate in Baldwin County, Alabama, and is interested in the proceedings incident to and connected with the probate of the will of his late father, S. A. Y. Dahlberg, which property cannot be conveyed by him without long and expensive Court procedure and which will cannot be probated without the appointment of a guardian ad litem to represent the said minor, all of which will cause unnecessary expense and delay, and for these reasons Petitioner alleges that it would be to the best interest of the said Willard McLeod Dahlberg, the minor aforesaid, that he be relieved of the disabilities of non-age.

THE PREMISES CONSIDERED, Petitioner prays that your Honor will make and enter a decree relieving the said minor, Willard McLeod Dahlberg, of the disabilities of non-age and that such other proceedings be had and such further orders and decrees made as may be necessary in the premises to invest the said minor with the right to sue and be sued, contract and be contracted with, buy, sell and convey real estate, and generally to do and perform all acts which he could lawfully do if he were twenty-one years of age.

Petitioner further prays for such other, further and general relief as she may be equitably entitled to the premises considered.

DECREE RELIEVING MINOR OF DISABILITIES OF NON-AGE.

This cause coming on to be heard was submitted upon the Petition of Claudia H. Dahlberg, the mother of Willard McLeod Dahlberg, a minor over eighteen years of age, to relieve the said minor of the disabilities of non-age, the written consent and waiver of notice of the said minor, and upon the affidavits of E. S. Tunstall, Jesse M. Smith and G. K. Page, and it appearing to the Court from the Petition and said affidavits that the said minor is over eighteen years of age, that both he and the Petitioner are residents of Baldwin County, Alabama, and that he is entirely capable of managing his own affairs, the Court is satisfied that it is to the best interest of the said minor that his disabilities of non-age be removed; IT IS THEREFORE, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court as follows:

1. That the said minor, Willard McLeod Dahlberg, be, and he is hereby relieved of all of the disabilities of non-age and invested with the right to sue and be sued, contract, buy, sell and convey real estate, and generally to do and perform all things, acts and deeds which he could lawfully do if he were twenty-one years of age.

2. The Register of this Court is hereby ordered, and directed to file a certified copy of this decree in the probate records of Baldwin County, Alabama, and tax the costs thereof with the other costs in this proceeding.

3. The costs of this proceeding are hereby taxed against Petitioner, for which execution may issue.
