

Comes now the Plaintiff in the above matter and moves the Court for a judgment against the Garnishee, Vanity Fair Mills, and shows unto the Court the following:


1. That on and to-wit the 9th day of August, 1976, the Garnishee was served with a notice and writ of garnishment in the above styled cause.

2. That on and to-wit the 16th day of September, 1976, the Garnishee filed an answer in the cause admitting indebtedness and stating "We will honor."

3. That on and to-wit May 24, 1977, the Plaintiff was advised by the Garnishee that they had not withheld any funds from the Defendant since they had elected to treat this as a mini-code garnishment under the Alabama statute rather than as a garnishment on a judgment under the Federal Wage Garnishment Law as required and as stated by the writ of garnishment served on the Garnishee.

4. That at all times pertinent to this proceeding, the Defendant has been employed by the Garnishee at a salary of \$3.20 per hour, working 40 hours per week.


In response to the motion for judgement filed in the above case, the following is submitted:


