TO THE HONORABLE, THE CIRCUIT COURT OF BALDWIN COUNTY, ALABAMA, EQUITY SIDE, AND THE HON. A. E. GAMBLE, JUDGE THEREOF, SITTING IN EQUITY: Your Complainant, Edna Hogan Clary brings this her original bill of complaint for divorce against the defendant, John Clary, alias John Zacharackas, and respectfully shows and represents unto this honorable court and unto your honor;.

### FIRST.

That both the complainant and the defendant are over the age of twenty-one years (21); that complainant is a "bona fide" resident of Baldwin County, State of Alabama; that John Clary is a non-resident of the State of Alabama, and when last heard from resided in Pensacola, Florida but his more particular address is unknown and cannot be ascertained by complainant after diligent inquiry on her part.

### SECOND.

That complainant and defendant were married in Nashville, Tenn., on to-wit; April 3rd, 1919, she leaving her home in Baldwin County for that purpose; that said John Clary's real name was John Zacharackas and not John Clary, and that said defendant married complainant under this assumed name.

### THIRD.

That shortly after complainant and the defendant were married the said defendant attempted to get from complainant all the money that *Complainant* she had saved, and, failing to do so, abused and threatened <del>Oratrix</del> and became violent toward her in his threats and threatened <del>Oratrix</del> that he would cut the throat of complainant with a razor. That defendant forbid complainant from leaving the house and virtually made a prisiner of her. That from his conduct toward complainant that

still has reasonable apprehension of violence on her attended with danger to life or health.

### PRAYER FOR PROCESS.

THE PREMISES CONSIDERED, Oratrix prays that a subpoena be issued to the defendant, requiring him to appear and plead, answer or demur, to this bill of complaint, within the time required by law, under the pains and penalties of this court, or for any other necessary orders to make the said defendant a party respondent to this bill of complaint. PRAYER FOR RELIEF.

# THAT UPON A FINAL HEARING OF THIS BILL, complainant prays that your Honor will render, adjudge and decree that the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the complaint, Edna Hogan Clary and the defendant John Clary, alias John Zacharackas, be forever dissolved; that your complainant be again permitted to contract the marriage relation, and for such other relief as she may be entitled to in equity and good conscience and such that to your honor will seem meet and proper. And, as in duty bound, she will ever pray, etc., etc.,
