

THIRD: That the defendant, Walter R. White, claims or is reputed to claim some right, title or interest in and to the land above described, or encumbrance the same, or a part thereof, and complainant now calls upon said defendant to set forth and specify his claim, interest or title in and to said land, and to show how and by what instrument or means the same is derived or created.

FOURTH: That no suit is now pending to enforce, test or determine the validity of the claim, interest, title or encumbrance of the defendant or the title of complainant.

TO THE END THEREFORE, that equity may be done in the premises, complainant prays that the said Walter R.
