SECOND: That complainant owns and holds for the benefit and use of the Alabama Insane Hospitals the South Half of the Northeast Quarter of Section Twenty-two in Township Four South, Range Two East, of the St. Stephens Meridian, in Baldwin County, Alabama.

THIRD: That the defendant, Walter R. White, claims or is reputed to claim some right, title or interest in and to the land above described, or encombrance the same, or a part thereof, and complainant now calls upon said defendant to set forth and specify his claim, interest or title in and to said land, and to show how and by what instrument or means the same is derived or created.

FOURTH: That no suit is now pending to enforce, test or determine the validity of the claim, interest, title or encumbrance of the defendant or the title of complainant.
