AMENDMENT TO ORDER OF COURT

The Order of Court heretofore rendered in this cause on the 16th day of November, 1970, by the Honorable Joseph M. Hocklander, Circuit Judge, sitting for Judge Telfair J. Mashburn, is hereby amended as follows:

It was stipulated by the parties that Mrs. Moore was injured and suffered twenty-five (25%) per-cent permanent disability to her left hand on November 16, 1969, as an employee of the Sea Gate Motel being owned and operated by Coast Properties, Incorporated, and while performing her duties as the manager of the motel. It was also stipulated that Mrs. Moore gave legal notice to her employer of the accident and her employer had actual knowledge of the injury suffered by her.

Paragraph two (2) is amended to read:

This Court therefore, finds that the Plaintiff is entitled to recover from both defendants the sum of ONE THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED THIRTY-ONE AND NO/100 (\$1,731.00) DOLLARS, representing fifty-five (55%) per-cent of SEVENTY-FIVE (\$75.00) DOLLARS per week for a total of twenty-five (25%) percent of one hundred seventy (170) weeks being forty-two and one-half (42 1/2) weeks less TWENTY-TWO (\$22.00) DOLLARS representing one (1) week of total/ temporary disability.

Paragraph three (3) is amended to read:

It is therefore ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that the Plaintiff have and recover of the Defendants a total judgment of ONE THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED THIRTY-ONE AND NO/100 (\$1,731.00) DOLLARS.

ORDER OF COURT

This case coming on to be heard on this the 16th day of November, 1970, before the Honorable Joseph M. Hocklander, Circuit Judge, sitting for Judge Telfair J. Mashburn, and upon the Complaint, answer and oral proof heard in open Court, is of the opinion and so holds that the Plaintiff, Bertha Moore, was injured in the course and scope of her employment while working for Coast Properties, Incorporated, when she fell and sustained an injury to her left hand; that the parties were subject to the provisions of the Workmen's Compensation Laws of Alabama, on December 15, 1969, when the injury took place and that on that date, Coast Properties, Incorporated, the employer, had insured his liability under the Workmen's Compensation Laws of Alabama with The American Fire and Casualty Company; that Bertha Moore was totally disabled as a result of the injury from December 15, 1969, to March 2, 1970, a period of eleven (11) weeks; that the Plaintiff was permanently/partially disabled to the extent of twenty-five (25%) per-cent; that the Plaintiff was earning an average weekly wage of SEVENTY-FIVE (\$75.00) DOLLARS per week and therefore is entitled to the maximum benefits of FORTY-ONE AND 25/100(\$41.25) DOLLARS per week under the Workmen's Compensation Laws of the State of Alabama.

This Court therefore, finds that the Plaintiff is entitled to recover from both defendants the sum of ONE THOUSAND THIRTY-ONE AND NO/100 $\,$

(\$1,731.00) DOLLARS, representing fifty-five (55%) per-cent of SEVENTY-FIVE (\$75.00) DOLLARS per week for a total of twenty-five (25%) per-cent of ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY (170) weeks being forty-two and one-half (42 1/2) weeks less TWENTY-TWO (\$22.00) DOLLARS representing one (1) week of total/temporary disability.

It is, therefore ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that the Plaintiff have and recover of the Defendants a total judgment of ONE THOUSAND THIRTY-ONE AND NO/100 (\$1,731.00) DOLLARS.

A lien of fifteen (15%) per-cent attorney's fee, or the sum of \$259.65, in favor of Taylor Wilkins, Jr., attorney for Plaintiff, is hereby declared upon this judgment as his attorney's fee for professional services rendered in this cause.

The cost of the case is adjudged against the Defendants, for which an execution may issue.

The Plaintiff, Bertha Moore, claims of the Defendant, Coast Properties, Incorporated, a Corporation, workmen's compensation benefits in the amount of, to-wit, ONE THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE (\$1,731.00) DOLLARS, arising out of the following facts, to-wit:

The Plaintiff, Bertha Moore, was employed as manager of the Sea Gate Motel, Baldwin County, Alabama, on December 15, 1969. The Sea Gate Motel is owned and operated by Coast Properties, Incorporated, a Corporation, domiciled in the State of Alabama. On, to-wit, December 15, 1969, the Plaintiff, while performing her duties as manager of the Sea Gate Motel, slipped and fell while in the process of cleaning up one of the motel apartments. She suffered a fracture to her left wrist.

The Defendant, Coast Properties, Incorporated, is a corporation engaged in the business of operating a motel in Baldwin County, Alabama, and was on the 15th day of December, 1969, subject to the provisions of the Workmen's Compensation Law of the State of Alabama.

That the Defendant, Coast Properties, Incorporated, on the aforesaid date had and maintained in full force and effect a certain workmen's compensation insurance policy issued by the American Fire and Casualty Company, through the terms of which the employees of Coast Properties, Incorporated, were insured against injuries and death arising out of and within the scope of their employment.

IV

The Plaintiff, Bertha Moore, is by trade a motel and hotel manager, and that upon the aforesaid date was a regular employee of Coast Properties, Incorporated, which said company was in the process of operating the Sea Gate Motel, located in Baldwin County, Alabama.

V

Plaintiff immediately gave notice to her employer of the accident and her employer had actual knowledge of the injury suffered by the Plaintiff.

VI

Upon the date of the aforesaid accident, and for some time prior thereto, your Plaintiff was being paid an average weekly wage of SEVENTY-FIVE (\$75.00) DOLLARS, which is of sufficient amount to entitle Plaintiff to workmen's compensation benefits under the laws of the State of Alabama, and more specifically as follows:

The Plaintiff is entitled to fifty-five (55%) percent of her average weekly earnings for a period of forty-two and one half $(42\frac{1}{2})$ weeks, which is twenty-five (25%) percent of one hundred and seventy (170) weeks. This is based on a permanent disability of twenty-five (25%) percent to her left hand.

VII

Plaintiff avers that the Defendant's workmen's compensation insurance carrier, American Fire and Casualty Company, has refused to pay her, and she therefore files this complaint seeking

to recover the benefits due her for the twenty-five (25%) percent permanent disability to her left hand as provided under the Work-men's Compensation Law, together with her medical expenses, if any, which have not been paid. The Defendant has actual notice of Plaintiff's injury, and Plaintiff is therefore excused from giving further notice thereof.
