

PETITION FOR WRIT OF HABEAS CORPUS

This, the Petition of Howard O'Neil Wiseman a/k/a
Howard Monday, show:

1. That Your Petition is illegally restrained of his liberty, by being confined in the jail of Baldwin County, Alabama.
2. The person restraining the liberty of the said Petitioner is Taylor Wilkins in his capacity of the Sheriff of the said County and the place of detention is at the jail of the said County. The cause or pretense of said restraint is by virtue of an illegal arrest made on your Petitioner for and on account of the crime of receiving stolen property or other charges which have not been made known to Petitioner.
3. A copy of such warrant or order of arrest is not available to Petitioner.
4. Petitioner further shows unto Your Honor that he has been illegally restrained of his liberty for three days prior to the date of filing of this Writ and that no cause for his restraint has been exhibited to him and no bond has been set for him.
5. Now therefore, Petitioner averrs that his further restraint is illegal and prays Your Honor to issue the State's Writ of Habeas Corpus directed to the said Taylor Wilkins in and as his capacity of Sheriff of Baldwin County, Alabama, requiring him to bring your Petitioner before Your Honor, at the time and place to be specified in the Writ for the purpose of examination into this cause of the detention of Petitioner.
