Comes your complainant, Flora J. Kaemmerer, and humbly complaining against Henry Kaemmerer, the respondent, respectfully represents and shows unto your Honor as follows:

First: That the complainant and respondent are both over twenty-one years of age and are bona fide residents of Baldwin County, Alabama, and have been for more than three years next preceeding the bill of complaint;

Second: That the complainant and respondent were married at Waukegean, Illinois on June 21st, 1933, and lived together as husband and wife, at Miflin in Baldwin County, Alabama, until on, to-wit, the 10th day of June, 1934;

Third: That on June 10, 1934, the respondent cursed and abused the complainant, striking her and driving her away from their home; that on various times prior to June 10, 1934, the respondent had cursed, abused and mistreated the complainant; that the conduct of the respondent was such that the complainant could not live with him;

Fourth: That the complainant and respondent have one child, Lillian Kaemmerer, now thirteen years old; that the respondent has cursed, mistreated and abused the said child, and that his conduct is such that he is not a suitable person to have the custody of said child; that the said child is now, and has been all her life, living with her mother, the complainant; that the complainant is able, willing and a suitable person to have the custody and care and control of the said child;

Fifth: That the complainant has no money with which to care and provide for herself and minor child, or to prosecute this suit; that she is in feeble health and unable to work;

WHEREFORE, the premises considered, the complainant prays that your Honor will by proper process make the said Henry Kaemmerer party respondent to this bill of complaint, making him plead, answer or demur to the same within the time and under the penalties prescribed by law and practise of this Honorable Court;

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That your Honor will order a reference to determine the amount of alimony pen dente lite: that the respondent should pay to the complainant and also a reasonable attorneys fee in the prosecution of this cause;
