A Justice of the Peace has the authority

further, by refusing to issue a show-cause order the defendant has interrupted a constitutional rights trial and this injunction still continues. The plaintiff is caused needless expense, loss of time, and both physical and mental distress.

The plaintiff claims damages of \$25000.00 plus legal expenses calculated according to the Code of Ethics of the Mobile Bar Association plus treble punitive damages. The right to prompt jury trial is expected.
