

Before me, the undersigned Notary Public, personally appeared James R. Cooley, who being known to me, and being by me first duly sworn, deposes and says on oath as follows:


1. I am President of Southern Host Inns, Inc., a corporation, and am the duly authorized agent of Southern Host Inns, Inc. to answer this writ of garnishment;

2. The defendant Lauree Parker was employed by this defendant on July 14, 1975, and until February 1, 1976; the defendant Lauree Parker left the employ of this defendant on February 1, 1976, and returned to employment by this defendant on May 1, 1976, and is still employed by this defendant. At no time during the employment of Lauree Parker by this defendant, however, have her disposable earnings for any week exceeded 50 times the federal minimum hourly wage in effect when payable, and the defendant Lauree Parker, therefore, has at no time during her employment by this defendant had any wages subject to garnishment under Title 5, Section 326, Code of Alabama, 1940 (Recomp. 1958);


3. Except for the above mentioned wages which are not

subject to garnishment, Southern Host Inns, Inc. was not, at the time of the service of the writ of garnishment in this case, or at the time of making this answer, or at any time intervening between the time of service of the garnishment and the making of this answer, indebted to Lauree Parker in any amount, and this defendant will not be indebted in the future to Lauree Parker by a contract existing at the time of the making of this answer, or at any intervening time, nor will it be liable for the delivery of personal property or for the payment of money which may be discharged by the delivery of personal property or which may be payable in personal property, nor does it have in its possession or under its control money or effects belonging to the defendant Lauree Parker.

WHEREFORE, premises considered, having answered this writ of garnishment, Southern Host Inns, Inc. prays that it be discharged.






