


COUNT I

The plaintiff claims of the defendant the sum of SEVEN THOUSAND & NO/100 (\$7,000.00) DOLLARS as damages for that heretofore and on to wit: the 16th day of May, 1970, the plaintiff's minor son was operating a school bus on and along U.S. Highway 98 at a point to wit: 2 miles West of Foley, Baldwin County, Alabama, and where the plaintiff's minor son had a right to be, and then negligently and there the defendant's truck was so/operated at said time and place by an agent, servant, or employee who was acting in the line and scope of his authority as such agent, servant or employee of the defendant, so as to run into, over, upon and against the school bus that the plaintiff's minor son was driving at said time and place, and as a proximate consequence of the negligence of the defendant, the plaintiff's minor son's body was crushed, and injured, which injuries caused the plaintiff to incur medical, doctor, hospital and ambulance bills. The plaintiff avers that all the medical, doctor, hospital and ambulance bills were a proximate consequence of the negligence of the defendant, agent, servant or employee, and that she is liable for these medical, doctor, ambulance and hospital bills and hence this suit.

MOTION FOR RELEASE OF EVIDENCE


