TO THE HONORABLE TELFAIR J. MASHBURN, JUDGE OF THE CIRCUIT COURT
OF BALDWIN COUNTY, ALABAMA:

Comes now your Petitioner, the undersigned Marion
Elizabeth Hughes, who is over the legal age and a resident citizen
of Mobile County, Alabama, and respectfully represents and shows
unto your Honor as follows:

FIRST:

That she is the natural mother of Lisa Anne Shiver, a
minor, whose age is two years. That on, to-wit, April of 1970,
she gave her consent for the adoption of her said minor daughter
by her Father, Jacob Thomas Shiver, Sr. and her Step-Mother,
Annie Ethel Shiver. That the consent so given was under extreme
duress and misapprehension of your Petitioner's rights inasmuch
as the said minor daughter is illegitimate. That the said Jacob
Thomas Shiver, Sr. and Annie Ethel Shiver filed a Petition in the
Probate Court of Escambia County for the adoption of the said
minor and the same was denied on, to-wit, July 12, 1971.

SECOND:

That subsequent to the denial of the said petition to
adopt, your Petitioner has made demands upon the said Jacob
Thomas Shiver, Sr. and Annie Ethel Shiver for the person of her
said minor daughter which demands and request have been refused.
That the said Jacob Thomas Shiver, Sr. and Annie Ethel Shiver now
reside at Blackmon Trailer Park, Spanish Fort, Baldwin County,
Alabama.

THIRD:

Your Petitioner further shows that the said minor child's
detention by Jacob Thomas Shiver, Sr. and Annie Ethel Shiver at

their residence in Spanish Fort, Alabama, is unlawful and that the said minor child is being illegally restrained and your Petitioner is being illegally deprived of the custody of her said minor child.

WHEREFORE, your Petitioner prays that a Writ of Habeas Corpus be issued immediately to Taylor Wilkins, Sr., as Sheriff of Baldwin County, Alabama, commanding him to bring the body of the said Lisa Anne Shiver before your Honor at the time and place to be appointed by you so that the same may be delivered into the lawful custody of its natural mother.

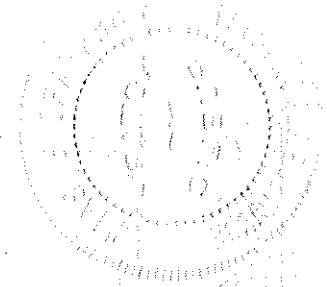

ORDER

This cause coming on to be heard upon the Petition of Marion Elizabeth Hughes and the evidence presented by the said Petitioner and by Jacob Thomas Shiver, Sr. and Annie Ethel Shiver, the persons alleged in said Petition to be unlawfully detaining and restraining the person of the said Lisa Anne Shiver, and the arguments of counsel; and the Court having considered all of the above is of the opinion that the relief prayed for in said Petition should be granted. It is, therefore,

ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED by the Circuit Court of Baldwin County, Alabama as follows:

1. That the Petitioner, Marion Elizabeth Hughes, be, and she is hereby, awarded the temporary care, custody and control of the said minor child, Lisa Anne Shiver, pending further orders from this Court.
2. That the Baldwin County Department of Pensions and Securities conduct an investigation to determine whether the said Marion Elizabeth Hughes and her husband, Derrick Hughes, are fit and proper persons to have the permanent care, custody and control of the said Lisa Anne Shiver and that the said Department report to this Court upon completion of said investigation.
3. That the said Jacob Thomas Shiver and Annie Ethel Shiver be, and they are hereby, restrained and enjoined from in any way interfering with, harassing or intimidating the said Marion Elizabeth Hughes and her husband, Derrick Hughes.
4. That the Petitioner herein, Marion Elizabeth Hughes,

be taxed with the costs of Court incurred in this proceeding for which let execution issue.

The Court hereby retains jurisdiction of this cause in order that it may issue such other, further orders or decrees as it deems necessary.
