COUNT ONE


Plaintiff claims of the Defendant the sum of TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND AND NO/100 (\$25,000.00) DOLLARS as damages, for that heretofore and on, to-wit: the 21st day of November, 1970, the Defendant did so negligently operate a motor vehicle on Alabama Highway No. 59 approximately fifteen hundred feet north of Baldwin County Road No. 4, both of said roads being public roads in Baldwin County, State of Alabama, so as to cause or allow said motor vehicle to run into, over, upon or against an automobile in which the Plaintiff was riding, which such automobile was then and there traveling on said Alabama State Highway No. 59 at said time and place; and as a direct and proximate consequence of the negligence as aforesaid, Plaintiff received severe personal injuries in this, to-wit: She was knocked against the front portion of the automobile above the windshield; she was rendered unconscious; she was made sick, sore and lame; she was bruised and lacerated; she suffered a number of contusions and abrasions; she suffered and continues to suffer great mental anguish and physical pain; and she was caused to be put to the expense of doctor bills, X-ray bills, drug bills, hospital treatment bills, bills for nursing care; hence this suit.
