

Julia Tompkins left Arthur Tompkins a few months after that and she has never lived with him as his wife since that ime. I know of no reason she had for tiving leaving him. This was more than two years before May 24th., 1920. Arthur Tompkins has lived in this county continusously all of his life. Willie Shongs dolph Sledge, a witness for the complainant testified as follows:-My name is Adolph Sledge. I live in Baldwin County, Alabama, where I have lived all of my life.
