COUNT ONE

Plaintiffs claim of the defendants the sum of ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED FIFTY AND NO/100 (\$1,950.00) DOLLARS, principal, plus interest thereon at eight (8%) per cent per annum from September 3, 1969, less \$170.00 paid on the interest, due from them by promissory note made by the defendants on the 3rd day of September, 1969, which note was due and payable on demand. Plaintiffs aver demand was made on defendants on, to-wit, October 17, 1969, which note in the principal sum of \$1,950.00, plus interest thereon at 8% per annum, less \$170.00 paid on the interest, is still due and unpaid.

Plaintiffs aver that in and by the terms of said note the defendants waived demand and all rights to personal property exemptions to which they are entitled under the Constitution and Laws of the State of Alabama, and that they agreed to pay a reasonable attorney's fee for the collection of said note, which plaintiffs claim and aver to be the sum of \$650.00.


