



COMPLAINT

I.

The Plaintiff claims of the Defendants, jointly and severally, the sum of SEVEN THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED AND NO/100 (\$7,500.00) DOLLARS, for that heretofore on, to-wit, January 2, 1972, at a point located immediately North of and adjacent to Alabama Highway #138, at a point approximately 1.4 miles East of the intersection of said Alabama Highway #138 and Alabama Highway #225, both public roads in Baldwin County, Alabama, the Defendant, Charles B. Duck, with the authority and permission of Horace Duck, negligently operated an automobile so as to cause it to run into, upon or against the Plaintiff who was then and there at said time and place, located where he had a right to be and as a proximate result of the negligence of the Defendant, the Plaintiff suffered severe injuries to his head thereby causing him to be hospitalized and incurring hospital and doctors bills all to his damages aforesaid, hence this suit.
