## ORDER APPROVING SETTLEMENT AND PETITION

NOW THEREFORE, it is ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED, by the Court that the said Petition, settlement and release be and the same are hereby approved, and the parties hereto are in all respects ordered to

conform thereto, and when the said payment provided for in said Petition shall have been made, the said Defendant Baldwin, and its insurance carrier, shall, without further formality, be forever released and discharged from any and all claims in any way connected with this matter, whether arising out of said Workmen's Compensation Act or otherwise.
