THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into on this the ~~14th~~ day of August, 1919, by and between SALEN KAHALLEY, as party of the first part, and SADIE KAHALLEY, as party of the second part, WITNESSETH THE FOLLOWING, VIZ:

WHEREAS, the parties to this agreement, who are husband and wife, have found it wholly impossible to live together any longer; and,

WHEREAS, the party of the first part has instituted a proceeding in the Circuit Court of Baldwin County, Alabama, In Equity, for the purpose of obtaining a divorce from the party of the second part, but it has been considered advisable, pending the conclusion of said proceeding, for the parties to this instrument to agree between themselves upon the questions of alimony, expenses of the said proceeding, and the custody of the two minor sons of the parties, the agreement with reference to all of the same to be embodied in the decree that may be rendered in the said proceeding, in the event such decree is favorable to the party of the first part;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is further agreed between the parties to this instrument that, if a decree is rendered in the above mentioned proceeding, granting a divorce ^{from bed and board} to the party of the first part, there shall be embodied in said decree, as a part thereof, the following, viz:

1:- That the party of the first part shall pay to the solicitors representing the party of the second part in the said divorce proceeding the sum of Fifty Dollars, (\$50.00), as their fee for the services rendered her in said cause.

2:- That, beginning with the first of the month next following the rendition of such decree, the party of the first part shall pay to the party of the second part the sum of Thirty Dollars, and that he shall pay to her an equal sum on the first of each succeeding month, as full permanent alimony, such monthly payments to be continued so long as the party of the second

part shall live and remain unmarried, but to cease immediately upon her death or marriage.

3.- That the party of the first part is to have the custody of the two minor sons named in the bill of complaint in the said proceedings, the party of the second part to have the right to see the said children at all convenient times, but it shall be the duty of the party of the first part to keep the said children in a school equal to the school they have been attending in the town of Bay Minette, Alabama, and to continue their education in that respect until they, respectively, arrive at the age of eighteen years; and, in the event the party of the first part fails or refuses to have the said children attend school, as herein provided, the party of the second part shall have the privilege of taking them into her custody and requiring the party of the first part to pay for their education, to the extent hereinabove mentioned; that is to say, to make such provision as would enable the party of the second part to keep them in a school of the kind and quality above described, for the time herein stated.

4.- That the said decree, if favorable to the party of the first part, may provide that all of the sums of money that have been agreed by the party of the first part to be paid by him, including permanent alimony of thirty dollars per month, shall be protected by a lien upon any and all property of the party of the first part.

IN WITNESS of all of which, the parties to this agreement do hereunto set their hands, in duplicate, on this, the day and date first hereinabove stated.

This Bill is filed by complainant praying for a decree awarding her the custody of the children of her and Respondent and for temporary and permanent alimony and Solicitors fees -

The demurrers challenging the sufficiency of the Bill and I believe are well taken. Equity has no power or authority in cases of this kind other than to compel Respondent to support and maintain his wife and therefore deals with the proposition of maintenance solely -

From the allegations of the Bill it appears that these parties are living together, possibly not very pleasantly yet there is no separation, and from the allegation that Complainant has no property or money, it necessarily appears that she is being supported and maintained by Respondent. This is all the Court could compel him to do -

The Register will enroll the following decree -

This cause is submitted for decree on the demurrers to the original Bill of Complainant and on consideration,

It is ordered, adjudged and decreed that said demurrers be and they are hereby sustained -

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that Complainant may amend her Bill within thirty days from this date if she is advised so to do, failing where in this cause is dismissed at the costs of Complainant,

TO HONORABLE A. E. GAMBLE, JUDGE OF THE CIRCUIT COURT, BALDWIN COUNTY, ALABAMA,-----In equity.

Your Oratrix, Sadie Kahalley, respectfully represents and shows unto your Honor as follows:

1. That she is a bona fide resident citizen of the County of Baldwin and State of Alabama, and is over the age of twenty-one years of age.

That Salen Kahalley is a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama, and is over the age of twenty-one years of age.

That both Sadie Kahalley and Salen Kahalley live in Bay Minette, Alabama.

2. That your Oratrix and the said Salen Kahalley were married about thirteen years ago and are now husband and wife. That Your Oratrix is the mother of two children and that Salen Kahalley is the father of both said children; that both children are boys; that the oldest one is named George Kahalley and is about twelve years of age; that Fred Kahalley is the youngest and is about ten and one half years of age.

3. That the said Salen Kahalley on or about March 2nd, 1919, choked and beat your Oratrix with his hand; that prior to this on several different occasions the said Salen Kahalley whipped your Oratrix; that the said acts of violence endangered the life or health of your Oratrix, and that there is constantly reasonable apprehension of such violence. That the said Salen Kahalley does not treat your Oratrix as his wife; that he ignores her absolutely, treating her as nothing more than a hired girl and refuses to have the proper relation with his said wife. That the said Salen Kahalley makes un-necessary trips to the City of Mobile, Alabama each week.

4. That the said Salen Kahalley is reputed to own very valuable property in the County of Mobile, Alabama, and that he is the owner of considerable property in Baldwin County, Alabama. That the property owned by the said Salen Kahalley is worth several thousand dollars

5. That by the said Salen Kahalley committing the acts of violence and mistreating your Oratrix it is unsafe for your Oratrix to live with the said Salen Kahalley. That your Oratrix have been faithful to the said Salen Kahalley and that she is now ready and willing to live with Salen Kahalley if her life or health was not endangered. That your Oratrix has no money or property at all; that it is impossible for her to care for herself and children; that your Oratrix has no home in which to stay and is now forced to remain in the dwelling with her said husband in order that she have shelter.

6. That the said Salen Kahalley has repeated endeavored to obtain a divorce from your Oratrix through fraud; that he sent your Oratrix out of the State of Alabama to the City of New York in order that he might obtain a divorce without your Oratrix knowing of the said divorce proceedings; that the said Salen Kahalley did obtain the decree of divorce fraudulently and that the said decree was set aside by this Honorable Court; that at the time Your Oratrix left the State for the City of New York, the said Salen Kahalley was extremely nice to your Oratrix treating her in this way in order to get her to leave the State, that he was very nice to Oratrix for some several days just prior to the time your Oratrix left for New York; that this proceeding is only one out of four different attempts to obtain the divorce.

Prayer for process.

The premises considered, Complainant prays that the said Salen Kahalley be made party respondent to this bill of complaint by the usual process of this Honorable Court, and that he be required to demur, plead to or answer the same within the time and under the penalties as provided by law, or that the same be forever confessed, *and all other orders and decrees as may be necessary to obtain the relief prayed.*

PRAYER FOR RELIEF:

That Your Honor will grant unto Complainant temporary alimony and attorneys fee for carrying on this litigation; that upon the final hearing of this cause Your Honor will grant unto Complainant the custody of her two children and a sufficient and

reasonable amount of permanent alimony suitable to the station and condition in life of your Oratrix and her two children and to the estate of the said Defendant, Salen Kahalley.

That your Honor will grant unto your Oratrix such other, different and general relief as she may in justice and equity be entitled.


