Comes now your Petitioner, Humble Pipe Line Company, a Delaware Corporation, and shows unto this Honorable Court as follows:

1. Your Petitioner is a Delaware corporation, duly qualified to do business in the State of Alabama. All Defendants are over twenty-one years of age. Defendants, Gary Ellis and Ann M. Ellis, are resident citizens of Mobile County, Alabama. Defendants, Scott Ellis and Doris Ellis, are non-residents of the State of Alabama, residing in Hutchins, Colorado.

2. Petitioner is a common carrier pipe line company and proposes to construct a pipe line from the Jay, Florida - Flomaton, Alabama, oil field for the purpose of transporting petroleum from Jay, Florida, across Mobile and Baldwin Counties to Mobile and thence to continental markets and markets throughout the world. Your Petitioner is authorized under the provisions of Title 10, Section 74 of the Code of Alabama (Recapiled 1958) to acquire by condemnation rights of way or easements over or across the land or easements of others for the purpose of constructing its pipe line or lines, and has previously obtained, pursuant to said Title 10, Section 74, a Certificate from the Alabama Public Service Commission under date of December 2, 1971, declaring that the construction of Petitioner's pipe line from the Jay, Florida - Flomaton, Alabama, oil field to its storage terminal in Mobile County, Alabama, would be in furtherance of industrial development by Humble Pipe Line Company or corporation or its privies in Alabama.

3. Petitioner seeks to condemn a right of way and easement for the transportation and transmission of liquids and/or gases through a pipe line or pipe lines, and all rights accessory to said right of way and easements which are deemed useful for the utility thereof, in accordance with applicable governmental regulations, including, but not limited to, the right to construct, maintain, inspect, operate, protect, replace, repair, change the size of and remove said pipe line upon and along and within said right of way, together with the right of unimpaired access to said pipe line, and the right of ingress and egress on, over and through the Defendants' land described below for any and all purposes necessary and incident to the exercise by Petitioner of the rights listed above, with the further right to maintain said right of way clear of trees, undergrowth and brush.

For the purpose of construction, installing, maintaining and operating said pipe line or pipe lines, Petitioner is desirous of acquiring by condemnation, an easement across the lands of the Defendants lying and being situated in Baldwin County, Alabama, said easements being more particularly described as follows:
