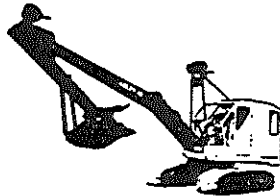


Dear Mrs. Blackman;

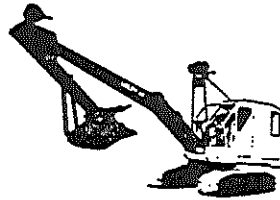


