Swift, and proof having been made to the satisfaction of the Court that the said Aubrey Suarez and Chas. A. Swift have good and sufficient excuse for their non attendance. It is ordered by the Court that they be and are excused. And the following of said persons so summoned to serve as Grand Jurors were then duly examined as to qualification by the Court and were then and there duly and legally empanelled sworn and charged by the Court. of this Indictment Alex Earle alias Alec Earle feloniously
took and carried away Four Hundred Pounds (400 lbs)
of Fertilizers the personal property of C. T. Phillips of the value
of Five Dollars against the peace and dignity of the State
of Alabama.
