The State of Alabama, (Circuit Court of Baldwin County,

It is remembered that a Court was begun and held
for the County of Baldwin, State of Alabama on the Fourth
Monday in October, 1909, the same being the 25th day
of the month; His Honor Samuel B. Browne, Judge Presiding
also were present the Clerk of said Court and the Sheriff
of said County when the following proceedings were had:

to their names except Jas M Bishop and John Menzel, and proof having been made to the satisfaction of the Court that the said Jas M Bishop and John Menzel have good and sufficient excuse for their non attendance, It is ordered by the Court that they be, and are hereby excused. Of the following of said persons so summoned to serve as Grand Jurors were then duly examined as to qualification by the Court and were then duly and legally empanelled, sworn, and charged by the Court, B F Geist having been appointed and sworn by the Court as foreman of said Grand Jury; Henry Lewis, Frank Earle, W H Stumyres, Jack Hym, A B Crosby, Joseph Menzel, E G Strong, John Resmonda, Ryard Roberts, B L Rendall, M W Roach, J J Holman, Frank Bugars, J W Richerson, J A McKenzie, and A C Nelson. And the said Grand Jury then retired under the charge of Sam Martin who had been duly appointed and sworn by the Court as Bailiff to said Grand Jury. And the said Grand Jury among other indictments returned the following:
