F. Priest having been appointed and sworn by the Court as foreman of said Grand Jury; Henry Lewis, Frank Earle, St G. Stammers, Jack Thym, A. B. Crosby, Joseph Stenzel, E. J. Strong, John J. Resmonda, Byard Roberts, B. L. Randall, M. H. Roach, W. J. Hoffman, Frank Bryars, T. H. Richerson, J. A. McKenzie and Al Nelson. And the said Grand Jury then retired under the charge of Sam Martin who had been duly appointed and sworn by the Court as Bailiff to said Grand Jury.
