The State of Alabama,) Circuit Court of Baldwin County

Be it remembered that a Court was begun and held for the County of Baldwin, State of Alabama, on the Fourth Monday in March, 1909, the same being the 22nd day of the Month; His Honor Saml. L. Browne, Judge Presiding, also was present the Clerk of said Court and the Sheriff of said County when the following proceedings were had:

And now comes Thomas A. Booth, Sheriff of said County and returns into Court his venire facias served upon the following good and lawful men who had been duly and regularly drawn in accordance with law to serve as Grand Jurors at the present term of the Circuit Court to wit: - F. S. White, W. M. Gibson, W. A. Grunstall, M. Standard, E. Lard, Aubrey Suarez, Louis Henderson, W. H. Warding, E. M. Reikerson, M. H. Harard, G. A. Duran, T. H. Boyles, Chas. A. Swift, N. N. Waldroup, Jas. A. Carney, J. Timney, C. T. Shipway, John T. Johnson, J. B. Davis, all of whom answered to their names except Aubrey Suarez and Chas. A. Swift, and proof having been made to the satisfaction of the Court that the said Aubrey Suarez and Chas. A. Swift have good and sufficient excuse for their non-attendance. It is ordered by the Court that they be and are excused. And the following of said persons so summoned to serve as Grand Jurors were then duly examined as to qualification by the Court and were then and there duly and legally empanelled, sworn and charged by the Court, T. H. Boyles having been appointed and sworn by

the Court as foreman of said Grand Jury: S. S. White, W. M. Gifford, W. A. Ginnally, J. M. Standard, E. L. Ard, Louis Glendenning, W. H. Harding, E. M. Richardson, W. H. Howard, G. W. Durant, D. W. Waldrup, Jas. A. Carney, J. H. Timney, A. T. Shipway, John T. Johnson, J. B. Davis And the said Grand Jury then retired under the charge of S. C. Byrne, who had been duly appointed and sworn by the Court as Bailiff to said Grand Jury.

And the said Grand Jury among other indictments returned the following:

Indictment The State of Alabama, Circuit Court
Baldwin County, Spring Term, 1909.

1. The Grand Jury of said County charge that, before the finding of this Indictment Jim Foster, having a wife then living unlawfully married one Margaret Graham.

2. And said Grand Jury further charge that, before the finding of this indictment Jim Foster having a wife then living unlawfully cohabited with one Margaret Graham in Baldwin County, Alabama.

(The defendant consenting to the same this Indictment is amended by adding the following count.)

3. And said Grand Jury further charge that before the finding of this Indictment Jim Foster, a man, did live with Margaret Graham a woman in a state of Adultery or fornication, against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.
