Kirk on said undertaking the sum of One Hundred Dollars unless they appear at the next Term of this Court and show cause why this judgment should not be made absolute.

You will, therefore, by serving a copy hereof, notify the said J. T. Bowman, J. E. Fleming and H. R. Kirk that the said judgment will be made absolute against them at the next term of said Court, unless they appear and show cause against the same.
