Organization of Court and Grand Jury. The State of Alabama } Circuit Court
Baldwin County } Fall Term, 1907.

Be it remembered that a Court was begun and held for the County of Baldwin, State of Alabama, on the Fourth Monday in October 1907, the same being the 28th day of the month; His Honor Samuel B. Browne, Judge, presiding; also were present the Clerk of said Court and the Sheriff of said County where the following proceedings were had.

And now comes Thomas A. Booth, Sheriff of said County and returns into Court his Venire Facias served upon the following good and lawful men who had been duly and regularly drawn in accordance with law to serve as Grand Jurors at the present term of the Circuit Court to-wit: John W. Lea, W. W. Cooper, J. C. Lamphier, W. J. Kee, E. H. Nelson, W. C. Foster, B. F. Feist, D. W. Murphy, A. M. Brodbeck, A. C. Grimes, Geo M^c Gowan, J. D. Kelly, W. H. Harding, Jas A. Carney, Chas E. Eubanks, B. F. Patterson, A. B. Myles, M. H. Roach and Martin Lowell. All of whom answered to their names except Jas A. Carney, and proof having been made to the satisfaction of the Court that the said Jas A. Carney has good and sufficient excuse for his non-attendance it is ordered by the Court that he be and is excused. M. H. Roach in open Court submitted reasons why he should not serve as a Grand Juror at the present term of this Court and asked the Court to excuse him, which upon consideration by the Court it is ordered by the Court that he be and is excused. And the following of said persons so summoned to serve as Grand Jurors were then duly examined as to qualification by the Court and were then duly and legally empannelled, sworn and charged by the Court, B. F. Feist having been appointed and sworn by the Court as foreman of said Grand Jury: John W. Lea, W. W. Cooper, J. C. Lamphier, W. J. Kee, E. H. Nelson, W. C. Foster, D. W. Murphy, A. M. Brodbeck, A.
