is entitled to the relief prayed for in

his said bill.

IT IS, THEREFORE, Ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court, that the bonds of matrimony heretofore
existing between the Complainant and Defendant be, and the same are hereby dissolved, and the said

Will Green is forever divorced from the said
Mattie Green, for and on account of
Voluntary abandonment,

as alleged in said Bill of Complaint;

It is further ordered, that the said Will Green
be, and he is hereby permitted to again contract marriage, upon the payment of the costs of Court in this cause.

It is further ordered, that the said Mattie Green
pay the costs herein taxed, for which execution may issue, and if such execution is returned "no property found,"
then execution for such costs may issue against the said Will Green.

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that said Will Green
shall not again marry except to said Mattie Green,
until sixty days after this date, and that if an appeal is taken within sixty days he shall not marry again except
to said Mattie Green, during the pendency of said appeal.
